

Mission-led Government: Understanding it

Workshop Overview

How can we develop practical ways of working that harness the collective energy, intelligence and creativity across the public sector and beyond? This workshop will explore how participants can ground the mission-led vision in the day-to-day practice of government.

The new government has set and adopted five missions. This re-imagining of government presents both an unprecedented opportunity and a significant shift in culture and ways of working and organising.

This half-day workshop will explore what 'mission-led government' really means in theory and in practice in a variety of Civil Service contexts. There will be a focus on the mindset and presence underpinning the use of insights and tools. The style will be highly interactive and experiential to support participants to make sense of their unique contexts together and give them an insight into their own practice and learning 'edge'.

We bring to bear Mayvin's expertise and experience: from building communities of practice in organisational change across the public sector to running our unique, practice-based Masters in People and Organisation Development and launching our recent Research Hub on The Future of Organisations.

Who is it for?

This course is designed for anyone with a role supporting their team, function or department in becoming mission-led. Typical participants include:

- Organisation Development and Design Professionals
- Strategy and Communications Professionals

Participants may be grappling with challenges such as:

- empowering and energising teams
- building broader and more diverse coalitions
- finding new ways to collaborate across and beyond government
- designing ways of working that drive experimentation and iteration
